Mark Heil, Moderator, Founder of Cerenova Fund Marketing, which provides marketing consulting services to fund managers in the specialty market of alternative assets. He is Series 7, 63 and 65 registered. All security transactions are effected through FCG Advisors, an NASD and SIPC member. Mr. Heil is a past President and current board member of the Entrepreneurs' Forum of Greater Philadelphia. Mr. Heil served as the executive director of the Philadelphia 100, recognizing the 100 fastest growing, privately-held companies in the Greater Philadelphia region, from 2003 through 2007. Since 1996, Mr. Heil has served as a board member for The Private Investors Forum (PIF). In 1998, PIF started the Angel Venture Fair, an annual event where early stage companies present to angel investors. Mr. Heil graduated with an MBA from Drexel University and a B.S. in Marketing and Finance from St. Joseph's University.

Scott Nissenbaum, Panelist, President of Finite Carbon. Finite Carbon is a forest carbon development company that creates and monetizes offsets. As President of Finite Carbon, he is responsible for assembling the management team and oversees the daily operations of the company. He served for three years as the lead investor and Chairman of the Board for ImageTree Corporation, a company with patented platform technology and a proprietary process that provides accurate and consistent assessment of forest resources to improve forest management and financial performance. His close involvement with ImageTree led him to recognize forest landowners' need for a single-source forest carbon development company that facilitates entry into emerging carbon markets.

Mr. Patrick Flynn, Panelist, a Founder of Enersol Incorporated North America and inventor of Hydrogen Odorization Technology. Enersol adds odor to hydrogen thus making it an acceptable and viable as an alternative energy. Patrick's core technical background is in the areas of fuel science, and the energy and environmental sciences, and his work in the alternative energy sector has earned him recognition throughout the hydrogen community and by his peers as a leader and pioneer in the field of hydrogen leak detection. In addition to managing a start-up company, Patrick also consults for a major international environmental consulting company, providing engineering consulting services for the alternative energy sector, and manages environmental monitoring programs at major industrial facilities across the US Northeast.

Andy Daga, Panelist, President and Founder of Momentum Dynamics, (MD) a clean tech company. He is an inventive designer with experience in advanced technology R&D in the energy and aerospace sectors. Momentum Dynamics is developing technologies that will enable Battery Electric Vehicles and Plug-in Hybrids to be charged wirelessly AND automatically. As the electric vehicle market grows MD's technologies will solve the problems of limited driving range, safety concerns associated with recharging cables, and help make EVs more affordable by extending battery life. These innovations in electric vehicle technology will help to propel widespread adoption at the commercial, governmental and consumer levels.

Emily Bockian Landsburg, Panelist, CEO of BlackGold Biofuels. BlackGold has groundbreaking, patent-pending technology to convert grease from the sewer system into biodiesel, a low-carbon diesel fuel. With its ability to profitably address the leading cause of sewer overflows for water utilities and produce biodiesel for up to 75% less than conventional models at similar scales, BlackGold is transforming operations in the wastewater sector from disposal treatment to profitable resource recovery while creating sustainable sources of renewable energy for cities across the nation. Blackgold made its first sale in 2009 to the City of San Francisco, have 2009 revenues of \$1.5MM, and have a formal collaboration with the US Department of Agriculture.
